

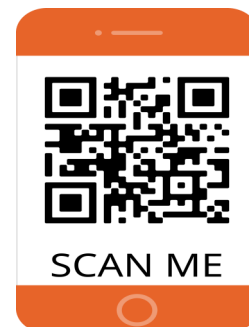
Ministers of Charity Update

As you know MOC is planning a **Build – a – Home event in 2023**. Mark your calendars for **March 18, 2023**. Build-a- Home event is our first major project of 2023 and requires much support.

Thank you to everyone who has already signed up. We currently have 24 volunteers (it takes 12-15 people per home) so we only have a handful of spots left. This is a great opportunity for families to be involved. After discussion with our partners, we are convinced that with the required day trip to Tijuana, this is a very safe event to host at this time. We hope you will consider joining us.

Funding will also help determine the scope of the event. It will cost about \$8,000 to build one home, with additional funds needed to support the event. SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL DINNER SERVICE: We have decided to restart our St. Vincent De Paul Dinner Service in 2023. New revamped safety/health procedures now in place, so the volunteer team size needed is smaller (only one Lead and 6 volunteers per dinner service).

We are scheduling six (6) Saint. Vincent de Paul dinner service events for 2023. The dates are March 4th, April 29th, June 17th, August 12th, October 14th, and December 2nd. To volunteer, simply scan the blue QR code to sign up.

Please consider joining one of these teams. If you have teens, it is also a very good family service project. Minimum age is 10 y/o.
